Geography (visit to Coventry and another location in a county)

- Name and locate counties and cities of the United Kingdom
- Identify human and physical characteristics
- Identify the position and significance of latitude, longitude, Equator, Northern Hemisphere, Southern Hemisphere
- Describe and understand key aspects of physical geography, including: rivers, mountains, climate, vegetation belts
- Use maps, atlases, globes and digital/computer mapping to locate countries and describe features studied
- Use the eight points of a compass, four and six-figure grid references, symbols and key to build their knowledge of the United Kingdom and the wider world

Design Technology

Focus: Textiles (Cash's Bookmarks)

Design

- Chn to design new and original products that are fit for purpose
- Communicate their ideas through discussion, drawings and, prototypes

Make

- Select from and use a wider range of tools and equipment to perform practical tasks [for example, cutting, shaping, joining and finishing]

Evaluate

- Investigate and analyse a range of existing products
- Evaluate their ideas and products against their own design and consider the views of others to improve their work

History (focus on a chronology of key events, people and places in Coventry)

- To create sketch books to record their observations and use them to review and revisit ideas
- To improve their mastery of art and design techniques, including drawing, painting and sculpture with a range of materials [for example, pencil, charcoal, paint, clay]
- About great artists, architects and designers in history

Music

Focus: Local music Scene

Pupils should be taught to:

- Play and perform in solo and ensemble contexts, using their voices and playing musical instruments with increasing accuracy, fluency, control and expression
- Improvise and compose music for a range of purposes using the inter-related dimensions of music
- Listen with attention to detail and recall sounds with increasing aural memory
