## Greeks

### History

Pupils should be taught about:

-Ancient Greece - a study of Greek life and achievements and their influence on the western world

### Art

**Focus:** Drawing, Painting and Sculpture (relating to Greeks-clay work)

Pupils should be taught to develop their techniques, including their control and their use of materials, with creativity, experimentation and an increasing awareness of different kinds of art, craft and design.

Pupils should be taught:

- to create sketch books to record their observations and use them to review and revisit ideas
- to improve their mastery of art and design techniques, including drawing, painting and sculpture with a range of materials [for example, pencil, charcoal, paint, clay]
- about great artists, architects and designers in history

### Geography

-to locate countries of the world using maps to focus on Europe. Focus on Greece, Athens and the Greek islands.  
-to use maps, atlases and globes and digital computer mapping to locate countries and describe the features studied.

- Physical and human features of Greece
