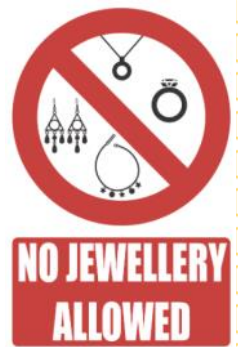

Earrings and Jewellery

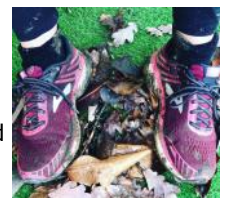
Please could parents and carers make sure that pupils are only wearing stud earrings in school and no jewellery.

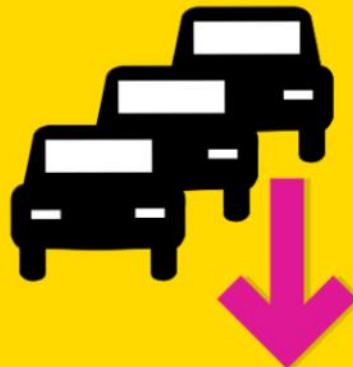
