Thankfully the situation was sorted by midnight and we could reopen on Tuesday! Although there are still ongoing road works on Lythalls Lane!

This situation has highlighted to parents and carers how important it is to have the correct contact details on record at school. The vast majority of the time we will never need to use these details—other than to send a reminder about

upcoming trip. But in an emergency they are critical. If you didn't get the message that school was closing due to a burst pipe, please let a member of staff in the front office know— either in person or a note with your child's name and your contact details. It might be since you originally gave us your details or checked the updates that you have changed telephone number, we can then check all the information on our system to make sure that if

the need arises we can contact you again!
