This term we are learning about ourselves and the people around us.

Me and my family

Personal, Social and Emotional Development

- I am learning to come into nursery by myself.
- I am learning to do more things by myself.
- I am learning to wait and take turns.
- I am learning to try new things
- I am learning to make choices and show favourites.
- I am learning to grow in self-confidence.

Physical Development

- I am learning to kick, throw and catch balls
- I am learning to walk, run, climb and use the stairs.
- I am learning to sit on a wheeled toy, use a scooter or ride a tricycle
- I am learning to wave flags and streamers and to make marks.
- I am learning to control different materials and tools.
- I am learning to control my large and small movements to do things on my own

Communication and language

- I am learning to listen to other people talking.
- I am learning to listen to simple stories with pictures and understand what is happening.
- I am learning to find the correct objects when an adult talks about it.
- I am learning to follow simple instructions.
- I am learning to talk about things I see and do.

Literacy

- I am learning to say some words in songs and rhymes.
- I am learning to copy finger movements and action.
- I am learning to sing and say rhymes by myself.
- I am learning to share books with an adult.
- I am learning to listen to stories and talk about the pictures and words.
- I am learning to have fun drawing freely.
- I am learning to talk about the drawings and marks I make.

Mathematics

- I am learning to join in with number rhymes.
- I am learning to sort and match colours, red, yellow, blue and green.
- I am learning to sort and match shapes,
- I am learning to sort and match sizes, using big and small.

Understanding the World

- I am learning to explore materials.
