Lunchtimes

Our school menus run on a 3-week rotation and change twice a year.

The school provides a free school meal for every child in Reception, Yr1 and Yr2. In Years 3-6 you will be required to pay for school meals which is £2.10 a day or provide your child with a packed lunch. If you are entitled to Free school meals, you will need to complete a FSM form online or collect a form from our school office.

Breakfast Club

This is an onsite provision and can accommodate children for breakfast from 8:00am. A form from the school office will be required subject to availability.

Afterschool Clubs

We offer afterschool clubs each term. On Monday's, Wednesday's Thursday's and Friday's. There are no afterschool clubs on TUESDAYS. To sign your child up to an afterschool club you will need the My Child At School App, with limited places available.

Attendance & Punctuality

It is very important that your child attends school every day to ensure that they have the BEST start to their education.

Short absences can impact children's learning and late arrivals can be disruptive.

If your child is ill or has a medical appointment to see a specialist, then proof of absence is required.

Holbrook Primary do not authorise term time holidays.

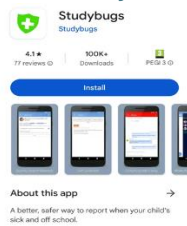
Any absence other than illness must be discussed with Mrs Bills (Headteacher).

Reporting your Child's Absence (Options)

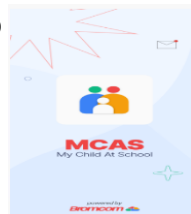

We have parent's evenings twice a year the first one is in the Autumn term to enable you to have a meeting with your class teacher.

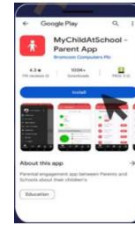

At times you may be required to make payments to the school such as school trips, dinner money, afterschool clubs. As we are a cashless school you will be required to make any payments via the My Child At School App (MCAS). Once your child has started, you will need to come to the school office and then receive an email to register for the app.

The My Child At School app also allows you to book parents evening appointments, monitor your child's attendance, view up and coming trips and afterschool club information.

If you have multiple children within the school, you will be able to view each child via the drop down box.
